Yenepoya Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, R.S No 29, 30, 31, Naringana Village, Post-Deralakatte, Ayush Campus Karnataka, Tah. Bantwal, Distt. Dakshina Kannada, Mangalore-575018, karnataka with 60 seats in UG (BHMS) course has applied for permission for the academic session 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 4/06/2025 & 5/06/2025, followed by an opportunity of virtual meeting with college on 11/06/2025 to ascertain the availability of all OPDs and hospital functioning. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls-

- A. Infrastructure: -Medical Education Technology Unit is available but less than the required size of 40 sq. mtr.
- B. Teaching faculty: -The college has a total number of UG faculty of 34 staff but there are cadre wise departmental deficiencies. The following are the details: -
- In the Department of Anatomy, Physiology and Repertory & Case Taking- 01Assistant Professor is not available as per the requirement of MES 2024.
- In the Department of Gynecology & Obstetrics and Community Medicine- Associate Professor is not available as per the requirement of MES 2024.
- In the Department of Surgery: Professor is not available as per the requirement of MES 2024.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 06 teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 60 seats UG college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No.:3- 2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 15 % relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. However, such a relaxed number of teachers should also be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

Teaching departments: - Research Methodology department is not available with community medicine

- D. Hospital functionality: -OT and Labor room are not functional as patients are referred to MoU hospital.
- E. Hospital staff: -
- a) X- ray technician and X- ray attendant, operation theater assistant and operation theater nurse, pharmacist and 01 house physician are not available.
- b) surgeon is on call against the requirement of fulltime as per MES 20-24
- F. Miscellaneous: NABL accreditation for clinical laboratories is not available.
- 2. With references of the above cited letters, no:- 4-7/2024-25/NCH(MARBH) (114-16)/3483 dated: 19/07/2024 and Email dated 17/06/2025 regarding reconsideration of intake capacity from 100 seats to 60 seats, MARBH has received a letter from the college to reconsider and revise the intake capacity to 60 seats in the previous letter issued dated 11/06/2025 vide letter no:- 4-7/2025-26/NCH(MARBH)(114-16)/2755-2762. Considering the above observations during inspection and virtual meeting, MARBH has decided to issue Conditional Permission to Yenepoya Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, R.S No 29, 30, 31, Naringana Village, Post-Deralakatte, Ayush Campus Karnataka, Tah. Bantwal, Distt. Dakshina Kannada, Mangalore-575018, karnataka with admission intake capacity of 60 seats for Undergraduate (BHMS) course for academic year 2025- 26 on the basis of following conditions: -
- a) The research Methodology department should be available with community medicine department for UG.
- b) Full-time surgeon should be appointed in hospital as per the requirement of MES 2024.
- c) X- ray technician and X- ray attendant, operation theater assistant and operation theater nurse, pharmacist and 01 house physician should be appointed.
- d) OT and Labor room should be functional in its own collegiate hospital as per MES 2024.
- 3. All admissions shall be made for NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that 100% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The counselling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government/NCH for the A.Y. 2025-26.
- 4. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
- 5. Condition under point 2 should be fulfilled within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification to the office, failing which permission for the academic year 2025-26 may be withdrawn.
- Letter no: 4-7/2025-26/NCH (MARBH)/ (114-16)/2755-2762 dated: -11/06/22025 stands cancelled. Thanking you,
